## Your checklist for changing banks

This checklist will help ensure the smooth transfer of your banking relationship to UBS.

- Make a note of your previous accounts and their corresponding IBAN numbers

- Draw up a list of your regular payments by direct debit (LSV+), standing order (DA), or eBill invoice
- Don't forget to change your credit card data if it is stored anywhere (iTunes, etc.)
